We write in support of the joint Community Planning Association of Southwest Idaho (COMPASS) and Idaho Transportation Department's US 20/26, I-84 to Middleton Road, BUILD Grant application. US Highway 20/26 is one of only a few east-west roadways that stretch from Caldwell to Boise in Canyon and Ada Counties. Its role as an alternative to I-84 makes it a vital transportation route, supporting more regional travel in the Treasure Valley than any other arterial roadway.
