	Nomination for a Service Academy.
November 15, 2019:	Nomination Application Deadline
	ALL applications and required materials MUST be postmarked
	by November 15, 2019. No exceptions will be allowed.

November – Decemb	er 2019: Review of Completed Applications by Service Academy Board
	The Academy Service Board has the option of interviewing all
	applicants who qualify for a nomination. The board will look
	closely at all aspects of those individuals who are being
	considered.
Mid-December 2019	: Announcement of Nominees
	The nominations will be made, and all nominees will be
	notified.
Beginning February	2020: Offers of Appointment from Academies
	Nomination by U.S. Congressman Russ Fulcher does not
	automatically result in selection by the Military Service
	Academies. Selection for appointment to each Academy is
	ultimately decided upon by the academies.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must meet the following requirements as of March 1st of the year of admission to the Academy:

I. Age:	The student must be between 17 and 22 years of age.
II. Citizenship:	Applicant must be a United States Citizen by November 1 of the application year.
III. Marital Status:	Must be unmarried, not pregnant, and have no legal obligation to support children or other dependants.
IV. Domicile:	Candidate must reside in the First Congressional District of Idaho.

Selection Criteria

Nominations from U.S. Congressman Russ Fulcher are based on a "whole person" evaluation. Applicants are considered for nomination based upon five levels of criteria.

I.	Scholarship:	Evaluation of academic records will include the applicant's
		grade point average, SAT / ACT scores, class ranking,
		student's willingness to embrace academic challenges, and
		if applicable any college records.

II. Leadership: Consideration will be made based on the student's leadership experience and potential command ability. The consideration of this qualification will be based upon the applicant's records of extracurricular activities. Quality of involvement is stressed over the number of activities.

III. Character / Motivation:

Consideration of the motivation and desire of applicants to attend a service academy is based upon the essay submitted by the applicant, their recommendations, and their interview before the Academy Nominee Selection Board.

IV. Medical / Physical:

The academies schedule medical and physical fitness examinations. Students will be notified when and where to report for these tests.

V. Competitiveness:

The final consideration of an applicant for a nomination is comparative in nature, appraising each applicant's attributes against all others who are applying.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

To be considered for a possible nomination, a student must read all guidelines carefully and complete all of the steps below prior to **November 15, 2019**. Please send all completed materials to:

All completed applications must be postmarked by November 15, 2019. No exceptions will be made.

Materials:

- **1.** Letter Requesting Nomination Submit a letter to U.S. Congressman Russ Fulcher requesting a nomination. This must be written in a formal business format.
- 2. Application for Nomination Return the completed Application for Nomination
- **3. Resume** Provide a detailed listing of your academic, community service, Extracurricular activities, athletic activities, and any other notable accomplishments.
- 4. Essay Compose an essay of no more than 500 words, which provides insight into why you desire to attend a Service Academy and why you would be a good candidate for admission. This essay must be separate and distinct from your letter.
- 5. **Photo** Attach a recent photo to your completed application (does not have to be a professional photo).
- 6. Letters of Recommendation Submit at least three letters of recommendation from individuals unrelated to you, who can assess your intellect, character, and suitability for military service. One from a teacher, principal, school administrator, guidance counselor, or academic dean; one from an employer or extracurricular faculty advisor; and one from a person of your choice. *These letters may be given to you in sealed envelopes with their signature across the seal or they may be sent directly to our office at the above address.*
- 7. Official Transcripts Submit a copy of your official transcripts to be sent directly from your high school (or college) to the above address.
- 8. Standardized Test Results Have your scores sent directly from the testing services to the above address or use our office's reporting codes: ACT-code 7371; SAT-code 5460. If your standardized test score is notated on your transcript that will suffice.



MILITARY SERVICE ACADEMY INFORMATION

The President of the United States, Vice President, Members of Congress and some other agencies and organizations have the authority to nominate persons for admission to a Service Academy.

Applicants should direct any questions regarding the admissions process for a particular Academy to the Academy's Admissions office. Applicants are responsible for initiating a pre-candidate file at each Academy to which they are seeking a nomination. Contact information for each of the academies is listed below.
