3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Keep Every Extra5 Penny Act of 2024".

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1SEC. 2. EXCLUSION OF OVERTIME COMPENSATION FROM2GROSS INCOME.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Part III of subchapter B of chap4 ter 1 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended
5 by inserting after section 139I the following new section:

6 "SEC. 139J. OVERTIME COMPENSATION.

7 "Gross income shall not include overtime compensa8 tion required under section 7 of the Fair Labor Standards
9 Act of 1938.".

(b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
for part III of subchapter B of chapter 1 of such Code
is amended by inserting after the item relating to section
13 139I the following new item:

"Sec. 139J. Overtime compensation.".

14 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by15 this section shall apply to amounts received after the date16 of the enactment of this Act.
