Congressman Fulcher is pleased to participate in the **2020** Congressional Art Competition. The competition is open to high school students, grades 9-12, residing in or attending a school in Idaho's First Congressional District.

Judges will choose the top three entries and the Congressman will choose the winner. All art work will be displayed on the Congressman's Facebook page, where a vote for the District Choice award will be held. The winner's artwork will be displayed for one year at the U.S. Capitol and the District Choice Award and Runner-up will be displayed at a District office.

DEADLINE: WEDNESDAY, MAY 22

Instead of dropping off or mailing your art to our Congressional Offices, students are asked to take a high-resolution photo of the artwork. Submissions can be sent via email to Alexah.Rogge@mail.house.gov and must include a release form found on our website.

GUIDELINES:

*Artwork entered in the contest can be **no larger** than 26"X26"x4" and no more than 15lbs. (with frame if winner) and must be an original in concept, design and execution.*

The artwork may be:

PAINTINGS

Oil, acrylics, and watercolor

DRAWINGS

Pastels, colored pencil, pencil, charcoal, ink, and markers

COLLAGE

two dimensional

PRINTS

Lithographs, silkscreen, and block prints

MIXED MEDIA

Use of two mediums

PHOTOGRAPHY

COMPUTER GENERATED ART
