Dear Majority Leader Thune,

In the last election, the American people overwhelmingly elected President Trump and gave him and the Republican Party a mandate to Make America Great Again. Core to that mandate was a promise to restore confidence in the security of our elections – to guarantee that only Americans vote in them.

During the Biden Presidency, the border was thrown wide open and millions of foreigners streamed into our country uncontrolled. Worse, that Administration and their Democrat allies at the state level provided millions of these foreign invaders with social security numbers and drivers licenses. They created the means and opportunity for election fraud.

It is imperative that we reassert a foundational principle: Only American citizens should vote in our elections. Anyone who wants to participate in that most sacred tradition should provide documentary proof of U.S. citizenship to register to vote and a photo ID for voting.

This is not a controversial position. An overwhelming majority of every demographic -- Republicans, Democrats, and Independents; White, Black, and Hispanic; men and women – share this same view.

The House introduced a bill that provided a solution to this problem, the Safeguard American Voter Eligibility (SAVE) America Act, a bill that passed the United States House of Representatives last month. Since then, the bill has stalled in the Senate, with no current plan in place for passing your chamber and being sent to the President's desk.

On Sunday, President Trump announced that he will not sign any additional legislation until the Save America Act is passed out of the Senate. The President has also called on the Senate to use the talking filibuster to secure passage of the SAVE America Act immediately, superseding everything else.

We agree.

Until that occurs, we, the undersigned, are prepared to vote NO on any Senate bill on the House Floor.

We made a promise to the American people. It's time to deliver.

Consider this our filibuster.






